Irish-Americans in Government was founded in February 1996, and is composed of current full-time or part-time of person or employees of the Federal, State, County, Village, Town or City governments, as well as Public Authority, School District, Special District and members of all publicly constituted Commissions, Boards, or Committees, including former of person and employees who have served two or more years in government, all of whom are of Irish ancestry.

The organization is designed to further the participation of Irish-Americans in government and to encourage fellowship among all Americans of Irish ancestry; to renew the traditions of Irish heritage; to generate support for establishment of scholarships for outstanding youths of Irish ancestry as well as to aid deserving charitable and educational causes.

QUALIFICATIONS: A candidate must be of Irish-American ancestry and complete each question on this application. The applicate must also provide: (a) copy of a school transcript; (b) two (2) letters of recommendation (e.g. guidance counselor, teacher, coach, clergy, community leader); and (c) essays (1) describing activities in which you have taken part and which are the most signibcant to you, and state why. Include also what impact your heritage has had on your life and describe any community activities and volunteer service in which you have been involved; (2) on The Signibcance of the Easter Uprising and Its Lessons for America. Each essay should **not** exceed 750 words. You may add such additional pages as you feel necessary to complete this application.

Your Scholarship Application, high school transcript, typed essay and letters of recommendation must be received under one cover by April, 15 2017. Incomplete and/or late applications will be disqualibed. Finalists will be contacted for possible interview and the scholarship winners will be announced in May. The scholarships will be awarded to the winners at our May, 2016 function. (IAG reserves the right to alter the number and/or size of the scholarships). Award winners are expected to attend the May, 2016 function.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Selection is based on several factors, which should be outlined within the text of your essay, with an emphasis on individual character, personal involvement both in school and community, especially activities that benebt the less fortunate. Merit is based on leadership in school, civic, and other extracurricular activities; academic achievement; and motivation to serve and succeed in all endeavors.
